## **FITNESS TO DRIVE** in **A Work Related Environment**



**Organisations and Individuals** are now beginning to see the importance of ensuring that their drivers have the appropriate licence and that their skills are at a competent level before letting them undertake work related journeys whether that be in company vehicles or using their own for the purpose.

**However** over one third of drivers who are killed or seriously injured on our roads are undertaking a work related journey at the time and many arise because they are not fit to drive.

- Are you aware that almost 20% of drivers prosecuted for drink driving are those who are driving "the morning after the night before"
- That more drivers than ever are falling asleep at the wheel through lack of sleep and rest and that stress related issues are becoming more commonplace in crashes.
- People in general are now more fearful of losing either their job or business that they are pushing themselves to extraordinary levels and driving whilst feeling unwell or taking prescribed medicines which by the very nature of their composition are making them under perform.

**The 2009 Annual AIRSO Road Safety Conference Wales** provides high value at a low cost and has been organised to equip individuals and organisations with the knowledge and advice on the dangers of driving whilst unfit and some of the consequences which can arise.
