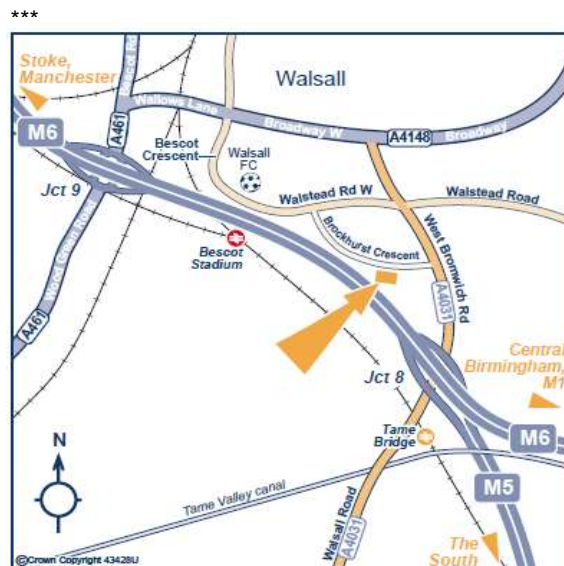
The Annual Saturday Seminar is for everyone but in particular is designed to help those who find it difficult to leave their workplace during a weekday.

- **Social Determinants of Injury and Road Safety**
Duncan Vernon MAIRSO: Road Safety Manager, England - RoSPA
A workshop about RoSPA's recent work on the social determinants of injury and what the implications are for road safety practice which will include how social factors are associated with the risk of being injured on the road and how we incorporate and use this evidence in road safety practice
- **Driving Under the Influence of Negative Emotions**
Diane Hall: DSA (ADI), TFT-Alg
Just as driving whilst under the influence of drink or drugs can seriously impair judgement, driving whilst under negative emotions such as anger, frustration, upset, stress and anxiety etc can also seriously affect judgement. This interactive session will focus on the detrimental effect of negative emotions on a driver's physical ability and share with you proven psychological techniques to eliminate these emotions, ensuring that drivers are in a fit mental state to drive
- **Greatest Advances in Driving Safety**
Tim Shallcross MAIRSO: Partner, Shallcross Motoring Consultants
A session which looks at advances in driving safety and not only identifies in your view what some of these may be but also explores just what contribution they have made in terms of casualty reduction and how indeed some of them actual perform.
- **Where is the Motorcycle Test Going?**

A considerable amount of research and time is being invested into how we can make the motorcycle test work more "efficiently" along with reducing casualties. This session will inform and allow for debate on current thoughts and ideas.
